Initial Notice to Creditors (Notice)

27 August 2026

Introduction

On 25 August 2026, Stephen Longley, Daniel Walley, Adam Colley, Andrew Scott and Rebecca Gill of Teneo Financial Advisory Australia Pty Ltd (**Teneo**) were appointed as joint and several Voluntary Administrators (**the Administrators**) of Universal Property Group Pty Limited, Raj & Jai Construction Pty Limited & associated companies collectively referred to as the Bathla Group of Companies (**the Companies** or **the Bathla Group**) as set out in **Appendix A** of this Notice, pursuant to section 436A of the *Corporations Act 2001 (Act)*.

During the Voluntary Administration, proceedings against the Companies or their property cannot be commenced or continued during the administration period without leave of the court.

According to the Bathla Group's records, you may be a creditor of at least one of the Companies.

The purpose of this Notice is to inform you about:

- the administration of the Companies
- your rights as a creditor

Our Declaration of Independence, Relevant Relationships and Indemnities (**DIRRI**) is attached at **Appendix B**. The DIRRI provides details of any relevant relationships that we have, and any indemnities or upfront payments that have been provided to us. In our view, none of the relationships disclosed in the DIRRI result in any conflict of interest or duty or affect our independence.

In reviewing this Notice, creditors should note:

- The information contained in this Notice is based upon our preliminary investigations to date. Any additional material issues that are identified subsequent to issuing this Notice may be the subject of further reports.
- The contents of this Notice are based on information obtained from the Companies' books and records, financial systems, representations from the Companies' key management, advisors and Directors. Any creditor that has material information in relation to the affairs of the Bathla Group which they consider may assist our investigations, should forward details to the appropriate email below as soon as possible:

- This Notice is confidential and not for general circulation, publication, reproduction or any use other than to assist creditors in evaluating their position as creditors the Bathla Group of Companies and must not be disclosed without the prior approval of the Administrators.

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1. Background

As referenced in the Introduction to this Notice, our appointment to the Companies set out in **Appendix A** was made pursuant to section 436A of the Act by the directors of the Companies.

The role of a Voluntary Administrator is to act for a company and in the interests of both the company and its creditors. This may include trading the business, employing staff, or winding down operations. A Voluntary Administrator is required to convene two meetings of creditors, at which creditors can vote on the future of the company. Further information regarding the Voluntary Administration is located in Section 2 of this notice.

You should carefully consider which entity or entities your claim may be against and consider the information in the relevant sections of this Notice.

Key information regarding any ongoing trading of the Companies is set out in Section 4 of this Notice.

2. What is a voluntary administration?

A voluntary administration is a process initiated by the directors of a company when they believe that the company is, or is likely to become, insolvent. This means that the company is unable to pay its debts or is likely to become unable to pay its debts. An administrator may also be appointed by a liquidator, or by a secured creditor. As set above we have been appointed as Administrators to the Companies by the directors.

A voluntary administration gives a company an opportunity to consider its financial position and its future.

According to the Bathla Group's records, you may be a creditor of one or more Companies. Creditors will be given an opportunity to vote on the future of each of the Companies set out in **Appendix A**.

3. What happens to your debt?

All creditors of the Companies are now creditors in the voluntary administration (**the Administration**). As a creditor, you have certain rights, although your debt will now be dealt with in the Administration.

It is important to note that a voluntary administration creates restrictions on creditors being able to enforce their rights. You generally cannot enforce your claim, recover your property, enforce your security, commence an action to place the company into liquidation or act on a personal guarantee.

We are using a Creditor Portal to conduct creditor registration and record creditor claims and voting at the First Meeting. You should receive a link to this portal based on your email address recorded in the Companies' books and records. If you do not receive a link to this portal by 31 August



2026, please contact us at bathla.creditors@teneo.com. If you wish to make a claim in the Administration, please lodge your claim via the Creditor Portal.

If you have leased property to or have a retention of title claim or hold a Personal Property Security registration in relation to any of the Companies set out in **Appendix A** and have not received correspondence from us, please contact us as soon as possible via email at bathla.pps@teneo.com

4. Operations and trading

During the Administration period, the Companies are presently continuing to trade until further notice while we undertake an urgent assessment of the Bathla Group's financial position including its access to immediate liquidity to support continued operations.

We will not accept liability for any goods purchased or services rendered by suppliers that are not made with the authority of the specified authorised signatories enclosed at **Appendix G**.

If there are any outstanding or unfulfilled orders placed by the Companies prior to our appointment, please contact us at bathla.creditors@teneo.com.

With respect to ongoing support to the Companies, please immediately:

- Close any existing account(s) in the name of any of the Companies and send us a final invoice/statement as at the date of our appointment. The balance of all outstanding invoices as at the date of our appointment will represent an unsecured claim against that company, you may complete and return the Proof of Debt (**POD**) via the Creditor Portal.
- Open a new account for each Bathla Group company where you are continuing to supply titled "[Insert relevant company] (Administrators Appointed)" for any authorised orders/charges/services made after the date of appointment and approved in writing by an authorised signatory.
- Complete the vendor creation form and return to bathla.creditors@teneo.com.

A right of set-off cannot be enforced between pre and post appointment periods.

If you have queries relating to any pre-appointment debts or your rights and obligations in the Administration, please refer to the online FAQ (frequently asked questions) document located in the Creditors Portal in the first instance, otherwise please contact the Administrators' office via email at bathla.creditors@teneo.com.

5. Court Application

On 27 August 2026, the Administrators filed an application in the Supreme Court of NSW seeking orders to facilitate the efficient administration of the Companies and to address practical issues

arising from the size and complexity of the Bathla Group. The application did not seek to compromise creditors' rights or alter creditor entitlements. Rather, the Administrators sought procedural orders designed to facilitate the efficient administration of a large corporate group and reduce unnecessary costs for creditors.

The key orders sought by the Administrators related to:

- **Modified notice procedures** allowing notices to creditors to be given primarily by email, supplemented by post where necessary, and by publication on the ASIC Insolvency Notices website and the Administrators' Creditor Portal. This is intended to provide a practical and cost-effective means of communicating with the large number of stakeholders across the Bathla Group.
- **Extension of time for responding to requests for information** from creditors, increasing the standard response period from 5 business days to 30 business days.
- **Relief concerning leased property liabilities**, including an extension of the period available to the Administrators to determine whether the Companies will continue to occupy any leased premises (being 22 September 2026) and a limitation on the Administrators' personal liability for lease obligations during that period.
- **Formation of a single Committee of Inspection** across all the Companies in the Bathla Group, rather than separate committees for each Company, to facilitate more efficient creditor oversight and decision making. This is discussed further in section 6 below.
- **Payroll-related relief**, seeking protection for the Administrators from personal liability for certain employee-related obligations arising from pre-appointment payroll practices where assets are insufficient to meet those liabilities.
- **Remuneration reporting relief**, allowing the Administrators to prepare a single consolidated remuneration report for the Bathla Group and to seek approval of remuneration through a single Committee of Inspection.

The Court subsequently made orders to the above effect. A copy of the Administrators' Originating Process (**Appendix H**) and the Court orders (**Appendix I**) are enclosed.

6. Meeting of creditors

We are required to hold two meetings for the Companies.

6.1. First meeting of creditors

The first meeting of creditors (**First Meeting**) will be held virtually (i.e. there will be no physical meeting). The details are as follows:

First Meeting Details

Registration:	In order to vote at the First Meeting, creditors will need to submit a POD and (where necessary) a Proxy Form in the Creditor Portal by 4:00pm AEST on Thursday, 3 September 2026 (i.e., the night BEFORE the meeting). If you do not register by this time, your VOTE WILL NOT BE COUNTED and your attendance at the First Meeting will be in the capacity as an observer only.

We enclose a Notice of Meeting, Form 529A, at **Appendix C**.

The First Meeting is required to be held within eight business days after the appointment of the Administrators. The purpose of the meeting is to provide creditors with background to the appointment and for creditors to determine whether to appoint a single Committee of Inspection (**COI**) (further detail regarding this below) to assist the Administrators, and if so, who are to be the members of the COI.

At the First Meeting, creditors may also, by resolution, remove the Administrators from office and appoint replacement Administrators.

To participate in this meeting you must:

- lodge a POD including information to substantiate your claim;
- lodge a Proxy Form via the Creditor Portal **by 4:00pm AEST (Sydney time) on Thursday, 3 September 2026 (i.e. the day before the First Meeting)**. If you have not received a link to the Creditor Portal by 31 August 2026 please contact bathla.creditors@teneo.com.

A creditor may also choose to appoint the Chairperson as a proxy to vote on their behalf.

It is important for creditors to note that unless you are appointing a proxy to act on your behalf, in order to participate as creditor at the First Meeting you will need to follow a three-step process, as follows:

Step 1 – Register to attend as a creditor on the Creditor Portal before 4:00pm AEST on 3 September 2026 (i.e the day before the First Meeting).

As our records indicate you may be a creditor of one or more of the Companies, a link to the Creditor Portal has been sent to the email address recorded in the Companies' books and records. If you have not received this link by 31 August 2026, please email us at bathla.creditors@teneo.com.

Step 2 – On the day of the First Meeting, log in to the Creditor Portal and click the meeting button which will direct you into the meeting.

Creditors should also note:

- if you wish to attend the First Meeting as an observer (i.e. without voting rights) please contact the Administrators by email at bathla.creditors@teneo.com; and
- Please note that it is not compulsory for you to attend the meeting and non-attendance will not affect the validity of your claim.

Committee of Inspection

Due to the size and complexity of the Bathla Group, we do not intend to put forward individual resolutions to nominate a Committee of Inspection (COI) for each of the Companies at the First Meetings of Creditors (**First Meeting**). As noted in section 5, the Administrators have sought and obtained court orders with respect to forming a single COI for all Companies in order to create administrative efficiencies and to reduce the costs burden on the Companies of having multiple committees.

The COI will be appointed by a joint vote of all the Companies' creditors.

In advance of the First Meeting, we will canvas the interest of creditors in participating in the COI. If you are interested in participating in of the COI, please advise the Administrators via email by no later than 4.00pm (AEST) on the day prior to the meeting by email to bathla.creditors@teneo.com.

The proposed COI will:

- Act as a voice to represent the interests of the body of creditors, as such we will seek to ensure that the COI represents a balanced cross section of the creditor population (eg: employees, sub-contractors, lenders, government or ordinary unsecured creditors etc).
- Liaise with the Administrators on various matters throughout the course of the Administration, including providing valuable feedback on proposed courses of action.
- Reviewing and approving the remuneration and disbursements of the Administrators.

An information sheet on the role of a Committee of Inspection is included at **Appendix F**.

We also anticipate, as is often the case, that some members of the COI may directly or indirectly have a financial interest in the conduct of the external administration in relation to one or more of the Companies, for example, if they are associated with a supply arrangement, funding agreement or other transaction or contract with a Company. Any such profit or advantage requires creditors' approval. We therefore propose to obtain creditors' approval for COI members to derive a profit or advantage at the same time as seeking creditor approval for the COI.

6.2. Second meeting of creditors

As Administrators, we are required to conduct investigations into the Companies' business, property, affairs and financial circumstances in order to form an opinion as to whether it would be in the best interests of creditors:

- that the administrations should end (and control of each of the Companies revert to its director(s))
- that each of the Companies enter into a Deed of Company Arrangement; or
- that each of the Companies be wound up, i.e. placed in liquidation.

A second meeting of creditors (**Second Meeting**) will be held to determine the Companies' future at which creditors will vote for one of the above options. The Second Meeting must be held by **29 September 2026** unless an extension of the convening period is sought and approved by the Court. It is our intention to seek an extension of the convening period. We will discuss this further at the First Meeting.

A notice of the Second Meeting will be forwarded to all known creditors of the Companies in due course.

7. Remuneration of Administrators

Included at **Appendix D** is our Initial Remuneration Notice. This document provides you with information about how we propose to be paid for undertaking the administration.

We are unable to take our remuneration without approval by a resolution of the creditors, a committee of inspection or a court.

8. Your rights as a creditor

Information regarding your Creditor Rights is provided in the information sheet included at **Appendix E**. This includes your right to:

- make reasonable requests for information
- give directions to us
- appoint a reviewing liquidator
- replace us as Administrators.

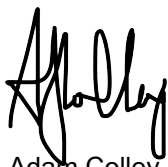

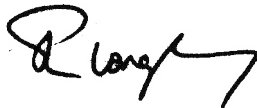

The purpose of the Initial Remuneration Notice is to provide you with information about how our remuneration for undertaking the administration will be set.

A. Remuneration methods

There are four basic methods that can be used to calculate the remuneration charged by an insolvency Practitioner. They are:

1. Time based/hourly rates

This is the most common method. The total fee charged is based on the hourly rate charged for each person who carried out the work, multiplied by the number of hours spent by each person on each of the tasks performed.

2. Fixed fee

The total fee charged is normally quoted at the commencement of the administration and is the total cost for the administration. Sometimes a practitioner will finalise an administration for a fixed fee.

3. Percentage

The total fee charged is based on a percentage of a particular variable, such as the gross proceeds of assets realisations.

4. Contingency

The practitioner's fee is structured to be contingent on a particular outcome being achieved.

B. Method chosen

Given the nature of this administration, we propose that our remuneration be time-based and calculated on hourly rates. In our opinion this is the fairest method because:

- it ensures that creditors are charged for work that is performed. Our firm has a time recording system that can produce a detailed analysis of time spent on each type of task by each individual staff member utilised in the administration.
- the Administrators will be required to perform a number of tasks which do not relate to the realisation of assets. This includes statutory work, including, ASIC reporting, investigations and responding to general enquiries of creditors.
- The Administrators are currently unable to estimate with certainty the total amount of fees necessary to complete all tasks required and whether there will be any delays to the completion of the administration (such as whether or not meetings might be adjourned, which would extend the administration time).

C. Explanation of hourly rates

The rates for our remuneration calculation are set out in the following table together with a general guide showing the qualifications and experience of staff engaged in the administration and the role they take in the administration. The hourly rates charged encompass the total cost of providing professional services and should not be compared to an hourly wage. Time is charged in six minute increments.

The hourly rates set out in this schedule are exclusive of GST and do not include disbursements.

Remuneration is approved by a resolution of the creditors, a committee of inspection or a court.

Estimated remuneration

At this early stage, it is difficult to accurately estimate the total cost of the Administrations given the complexity and size of the group of entities. Our best estimate is that the Voluntary Administration period will cost in the order of \$2m to \$3m ex GST for the first six weeks. Our best estimate for an extended Voluntary Administration period (inclusive of the first six weeks) is \$5m to \$10m ex GST subject to the following variables (without limitation) which will have a significant effect on this estimate provided and that we are unable to determine at this time:

- The length and complexity of:
 - Dealing with a large number of secured financiers to certain Group entities
 - Ongoing construction/management of the various building sites in the Group
 - Sale processes to sell the properties in the Group
 - Operational issues relating to trading of the Group entities
- The length of time in which the convening period (and by extension the administration period) is extended by the Court
- Our involvement in other legal processes that we may need to address as part of the administration process
- Volume of correspondence with creditors and adjudication of creditor claims
- Other unforeseen events

D. Disbursements

Disbursements are divided into three types:

- **External professional services** - these are recovered at cost. An example of an externally provided professional service disbursement is legal fees.
- **External non-professional costs** - these are recovered at cost. Examples of externally provided non-professional costs are travel, accommodation, search fees, lodgement fees, storage, outsourced printing and photocopying services.
- **Firm non-professional costs** such as photocopying, printing and postage. These disbursements, if charged to the administration, would generally be charged at cost; though some expenses such as photocopying and printing may be charged at a rate which recoups both variable and fixed costs. The recovery of these costs must be on a reasonable commercial basis.

We are not required to seek creditor approval for disbursements paid to third parties, but must account to creditors. However, we must be satisfied that these disbursements are appropriate, justified and reasonable.

We are required to obtain creditor's consent for the payment of internal disbursements. Creditors will be asked to approve our internal disbursements prior to these disbursements being paid from the administration.

Details of the basis of recovering disbursements in this administration are provided below. Full details of any actual costs incurred will be provided with future reporting.

**Appendix E Information Sheet – Creditors Rights in Voluntary
Administration**

Creditor Rights in Voluntary Administrations

As a creditor, you have rights to request meetings and information or take certain actions:



Right to request information

Information is communicated to creditors in a voluntary administration through reports and meetings.

In a voluntary administration, two meetings of creditors are automatically held. You should expect to receive reports and notice of these meetings:

- The first meeting is held within 8 business days of the voluntary administrator's appointment. A notice of meeting and other information for this meeting will be issued to all known creditors.
- The second, or decision, meeting is usually held within 6 weeks of the appointment, unless an extension is granted. At this meeting, creditors will get to make a decision about the company's future. Prior to this meeting the voluntary administrator will provide creditors with a notice of the meeting and a detailed report to assist in making your decision.

Important information will be communicated to creditors prior to and during these meetings. Creditors are unable to request additional meetings in a voluntary administration.

Creditors have the right to request information at any time. A voluntary administrator must provide a creditor with the requested information if their request is 'reasonable', the information is relevant to the voluntary administration, and the provision of the information would not cause the voluntary administrator to breach their duties.

A voluntary administrator must provide this information to a creditor within 5 business days of receiving the request, unless a longer period is agreed. If, due to the nature of the information requested, the voluntary administrator requires more time to comply with the request, they can extend the period by notifying the creditor in writing.

Requests must be reasonable.

They are not reasonable if:

- (a) complying with the request would prejudice the interests of one or more creditors or a third party
- (b) the information requested would be privileged from production in legal proceedings
- (c) disclosure would found an action for breach of confidence
- (d) there is not sufficient available property to comply with the request
- (e) the information has already been provided
- (f) the information is required to be provided under law within 20 business days of the request
- (g) the request is vexatious

If a request is not reasonable due to (d), (e) or (f) above, the voluntary administrator must comply if the creditor meets the cost of complying with the request.

Otherwise, a voluntary administrator must inform a creditor if their information request is not reasonable and the reason why.

Right to give directions to voluntary administrator

Creditors, by resolution, may give a voluntary administrator directions in relation to a voluntary administration. A voluntary administrator must have regard to these directions, but they are not required to comply with the directions.

If a voluntary administrator chooses not to comply with a direction given by a resolution of the creditors, they must document their reasons for not complying.

An individual creditor cannot provide a direction to a voluntary administrator.

Right to appoint a reviewing liquidator

Creditors, by resolution, may appoint a reviewing liquidator to review a voluntary administrator's remuneration or a cost or expense incurred in a voluntary administration. The review is limited to:

- remuneration approved within the six months prior to the appointment of the reviewing liquidator, and
- expenses incurred in the 12 months prior to the appointment of the reviewing liquidator.

The cost of the reviewing liquidator is paid from the assets of the voluntary administration, in priority to creditor claims.

An individual creditor can appoint a reviewing liquidator with the voluntary administrator's consent, however the cost of this reviewing liquidator must be met personally by the creditor making the appointment.

Right to replace voluntary administrator

At the first meeting, creditors have the right to remove a voluntary administrator and appoint another registered liquidator to act as voluntary administrator.

A creditor must ensure that they have a consent from another registered liquidator prior to the first meeting if they wish to seek the removal and replacement of a voluntary administrator.

Creditors also have the opportunity to replace a voluntary administrator at the second meeting of creditors:

- If creditors vote to accept a proposed deed of company arrangement, they can appoint a different registered liquidator as the deed administrator.
- If creditors vote to place the company into liquidation, they can appoint a different registered liquidator as the liquidator.

It is however usual for the voluntary administrator to act as deed administrator or liquidator. It would be expected that additional costs would be incurred by an alternate deed administrator or liquidator to gain the level of knowledge of the voluntary administrator.

Like with the first meeting, a creditor must ensure that they have a consent from another registered liquidator prior to the second meeting if they wish to seek to appoint an alternative registered liquidator as deed administrator or liquidator.

Appendix F Information Sheet – Committee of Inspection

Information Sheet: Committees of Inspection

You have been elected to be, or are considering standing for the role of, a member of a Committee of Inspection (COI) in either a liquidation, voluntary administration or deed of company arrangement of a company (collectively referred to as an external administration).

This information sheet is to assist you with understanding your rights and responsibilities as a member of a COI.

What is a COI?

A COI is a small group of creditors elected to represent the interests of creditors in the external administration. The COI advises and assists the external administrator and also has the power to approve and request certain things – this is discussed in more detail below.

Membership of the COI is a voluntary, unpaid position.

Who can be elected to a COI?

To be eligible to be appointed as a member of a COI, a person must be:

- A creditor
- A person holding the power of attorney of a creditor
- A person authorised in writing by a creditor; or
- A representative of the Commonwealth where a claim for financial assistance has, or is likely to be, made in relation to unpaid employee entitlements.

If a member of the COI is a company, it can be represented by an individual authorised in writing to act on that creditor's behalf. It also allows the creditor to maintain its representation if a change in the individual is required

A COI usually has between 5 and 7 members, though it can have more, or less, depending on the size of the external administration.

A member of a COI can be appointed by:

- resolution at a meeting of creditors
- an employee or a group of employees owed at least 50% of the entitlements owed to employees of the company
- a large creditor or group of creditors that are owed at least 10% of the value of the creditors' claims,

If an employee or group of employees, or a large creditor or group of creditors, appoints a member to the COI, they cannot vote on the general resolution of creditors to appoint members to the COI. Each of these groups also have the power to remove their appointed member of the COI and appoint someone else.

If you are absent from 5 consecutive meetings of the COI without leave of the COI or you become an insolvent under administration, you are removed from the COI.

What are the roles and powers of a COI?

A COI has the following roles:

- to advise and assist the liquidator, voluntary administrator or deed administrator (collectively referred to as the external administrator)
- to give directions to the external administrator
- to monitor the conduct of the external administration.

In respect of directions, the external administrator is only required to have regard to those directions. If there is a conflict between the directions of the COI and the creditors, the directions of the creditors prevail. If the external administrator chooses not to comply with the directions of the COI, the external administrator must document why.

A COI also has the power to:

- approve remuneration of the external administrator after the external administrator has provided the COI with a Remuneration Approval Report (a detailed report setting out the remuneration for undertaking the external administration)
- approve the use of some of the external administrator's powers in a liquidation (compromise of debts over \$100,000 and entering into contracts over 3 months)
- require the external administrator to convene a meeting of the company's creditors
- request information from the external administrator
- approve the destruction of the books and records of the external administration on the conclusion of the external administration
- with the approval of the external administrator, obtain specialist advice or assistance in relation to the conduct of the external administration
- apply to the Court for the Court to enquire into the external administration.

An external administrator is not required to convene a meeting of creditors if the request by the COI is unreasonable, or provide requested information if the request is unreasonable, not relevant to the administration or would cause the external administrator to breach their duties.

A request to convene a meeting of creditors is unreasonable if:

- it would substantially prejudice the interests of a creditor or third party
- there are insufficient funds in the external administration to cover the cost of the request
- a meeting of creditors dealing with the same matters has already been held or will be held within 15 business days, or
- the request is vexatious.

If a request for a meeting is reasonable, the external administrator must hold a meeting of creditors as soon as reasonably practicable.

A request for information is unreasonable if:

- it would substantially prejudice the interests of a creditor or third party
- the information would be subject to legal professional privilege
- disclosure of the information would be a breach of confidence
- there are insufficient funds in the external administration to cover the cost of the request
- the information has been provided or is required to be provided within 20 business days, or
- the request is vexatious.

If the request for information is not unreasonable, the external administrator must provide the requested information within 5 business days, but the law provides for further time in certain circumstances.

An external administrator must inform the COI if their meeting or information request is not reasonable and the reason why.

How does the COI exercise its powers?

A COI exercises its powers by passing resolutions at meetings of the COI. To pass a resolution, a meeting must be convened and a majority of the members of the COI must be in attendance.

A meeting is convened by the external administrator by giving notice of the meeting to the members of the COI. Meetings of the COI can be convened at short notice. The external administrator must keep minutes of the meeting and lodge them with ASIC within one month of the end of the meeting.

ASIC is entitled to attend any meeting of a COI.

What restrictions are there on COI members?

A member of a COI must not directly or indirectly derive any profit or advantage from the external administration. This includes by purchasing assets of the company or by entering into a transaction with the company or a creditor of the company. This prohibition extends to related entities of the member of the COI and a large creditor(s) that appoints a member to the COI.

Creditors, by resolution at a meeting of creditors, can resolve to allow the transaction. The member of the COI or the large creditor(s) that appoints a member to the COI is not allowed to vote on the resolution.

Where can you get more information?

The Australian Restructuring Insolvency and Turnaround Association (ARITA) provides information to assist creditors with understanding external administrations and insolvency. This information is available from ARITA's website at www.arita.com.au/creditors.

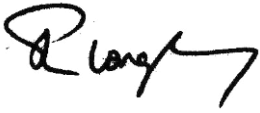
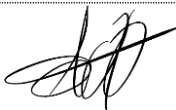

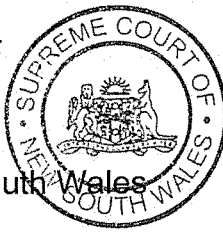

A. DETAILS OF APPLICATION

This application is made under sections 443B and 447A of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (**Corporations Act**) and section 90-15 of the Insolvency Practice Schedule (Corporations) (**IPSC**), being Schedule 2 to the *Corporations Act*.

This proceeding is an application for various orders regarding the voluntary administration of the Second to Five Hundred and Forty-Third Plaintiff companies.

On the facts stated in the supporting affidavit of Andrew John Scott sworn 26 August 2026 (**Supporting Affidavit**) and Exhibit AJS-1 to the Supporting Affidavit, the Plaintiffs claim the following relief:

Interlocutory relief

- 1 An order granting leave to file in Court this Originating Process and the Supporting Affidavit.
- 2 An order that this Originating Process be made returnable instant.
- 3 Pursuant to rule 1.3 of the *Supreme Court (Corporations) Rules 1999* (NSW) or section 61(1) of the *Civil Procedure Act 2005* (NSW), an order dispensing with the requirement of rule 2.4(2) of the *Supreme Court (Corporations) Rules 1999* (NSW), to the extent that rule requires the Supporting Affidavit to annex or

Final relief

Notification to creditors, owners and lessors

- 4 An order pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC that Part 5.3A of the Corporations Act is to operate as if any notice (**Notice**) required to be given by the First Plaintiffs pursuant to section 436E(3) of the Corporations Act and rule 75-15 of the *Insolvency Practice Rules (Corporations)* 2016 (Cth) (**IPR**) has been validly given to the creditors of the Second to Five Hundred and Forty-Third Plaintiffs (**Companies**) upon the following steps having been taken by 1 September 2026 or, in any event, not less than 4 business days before the first meeting of creditors (**First Meeting**):
 - a. where the First Plaintiffs have an email address for a creditor, by notifying each such creditor, via email, of the Notice;
 - b. where the First Plaintiffs do not have an email address for a creditor but have a postal address for that creditor (or have received notification of non-delivery of a notice sent by email in accordance with subparagraph (a) above), by notifying each such creditor, via post, of the Notice;
 - c. by causing the Notice to be published on the website maintained by ASIC at <https://insolvencynotices.asic.gov.au/> (**ASIC Published Notices Website**); and
 - d. by causing the Notice to be published on the creditor portal maintained by the First Plaintiffs' third-party provider EXAD.

- 5 An order, pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC that, if pursuant to any provision of Part 5.3A of the Corporations Act, IPSC or IPR the First Plaintiffs were or are required or permitted to provide any other notification to the creditors of the Companies, or owners or lessors of property occupied by or in the possession of the Companies, during the administration of the Companies, the applicable notice requirements will be or have been satisfied if the Plaintiffs give or gave such notice by taking the following steps:
 - a. where the First Plaintiffs have an email address for a creditor, owner or lessor, by notifying each such creditor, owner or lessor, via email;
 - b. where the First Plaintiffs do not have an email address for a creditor, owner or lessor but have a postal address for that creditor, owner or lessor (or have received notification of non-delivery of a notice sent by email in accordance with subparagraph (a) above), by notifying each such creditor, owner or lessor, via post;
 - c. if applicable to the relevant notification, by causing the relevant notification to be published on the ASIC Published Notices Website; and
 - d. by causing the relevant notification to be published on the creditor portal maintained by the First Plaintiffs' third-party provider EXAD.

- 6 An order pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC, that section 70-1(2)(a) of the IPR is to operate in relation to the Companies as if the words "*5 business days after receiving the request*" be read as "*30 business days after receiving the request*".

Limitation of liability

- 7 An order pursuant to sections 443B(8) and 447A of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC that any personal liability of the First Plaintiffs under section 443B(2) in respect of leases of property leased to the Companies begins from 22 September 2026, and that rent and other amounts payable under those leases before that date are not expenses incurred by the First Plaintiffs in carrying on the business of the Companies.
- 8 An order pursuant to section 447A of the Corporations Act that Part 5.3A of the Corporations Act is to operate in relation to the voluntary administration of each of the Companies as if, in relation to each of those Companies, the words "*within five business days after the beginning of the administration*" in section 443B(3) of the Corporations Act instead read "*before 22 September 2026*".

Committee of inspection

- 9 An order pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC that Divisions 75 and 80 of the IPSC and Division 75 of the IPR are to operate so that:
- a. a single committee of inspection be formed in respect of the Companies;
 - b. at the First Meetings of the Companies, the First Plaintiffs are to put a proposal (**Proposal**) to the creditors of the Companies that the members of the committee of inspection be the persons as proposed by the First Plaintiffs, in accordance with paragraph 96 of the Supporting Affidavit;
 - c. the First Plaintiffs invite the creditors of the Companies to vote either Yes or No to the Proposal;
 - d. the creditors of all Companies are to vote jointly in respect of the Proposal;
 - e. if the Proposal is taken to have passed in accordance with rules 75-110 and 75-115(1) of the IPR (as applicable), then the members of the committee of inspection be the persons proposed by the First Plaintiffs, as set out under subsection (b); and
 - f. if the Proposal is taken to not have passed in accordance with rules 75-110 and 75-115(1) (as applicable), then there is to be no further vote at the first meeting on the question of the formation of a Committee of Inspection for any of the Second to Five Hundred and Forty Third Plaintiffs and there be liberty to apply with respect to the formation of a committee of inspection to the First Plaintiffs and the creditors of the Companies on 3 business days' notice, specifying the relief sought.
- 10 An order pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC that Division 80 of the IPSC and Division 80 of the IPR are to operate so that the committee of inspection may appoint one or more additional members to the committee and a person so appointed represents the creditors.

Payroll

- 11 An order pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC that Part 5.3A of the Corporations Act is to operate, *nunc pro tunc*, in relation to the First Plaintiffs and each of the Companies as if section 443A(1) of the Corporations Act provides that, with respect to the liabilities of the First Plaintiffs incurred with respect to any obligations or liabilities arising out of, or in connection with, agreements entered into between the Companies and any of the Companies' employees or subcontractors prior to the appointment of the First Plaintiffs, the First Plaintiffs will not be personally liable to repay such debts or satisfy such liabilities to the extent that:
- a. any such obligations or liabilities have been incurred or have arisen, or are incurred or arise in the future, as a consequence of the First Plaintiffs implementing the Pre-Appointment Employee Practices set out in Schedule 2 to these orders; and
 - b. the assets of the Companies are insufficient to satisfy any such obligations or liabilities.

Remuneration report

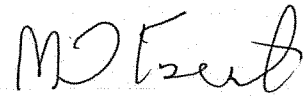
- 12 An order, pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC, that section 60-10 of the IPSC is to operate, in relation to each of the Companies, as if:
- a. one consolidated remuneration report may be prepared for all Companies (identifying where any Company's provided remuneration is different, for example because of specific work done in respect of that Company, alone), for the purposes of any remuneration determination; and
 - b. any remuneration determination may be approved by any single committee of inspection appointed pursuant to the orders made in this proceeding.

Ancillary orders

- 13 An order that within 3 business days of the making of these orders, the First Plaintiffs take all reasonable steps to cause a copy of this Originating Process and the orders made to be given to ASIC, as well as the creditors (including persons or entities claiming to be creditors), owners and lessors of the Companies in the following manner:
- a. where the First Plaintiffs have an email address for a creditor, owner or lessor, by notifying each such creditor, owner or lessor, via email, of the making of these orders and providing a link to a website where the creditor, owner or lessor may download the orders and the Originating Process;
 - b. where the First Plaintiffs do not have an email address for a creditor, owner or lessor but have a postal address for that creditor, owner or lessor (or have received notification of non-delivery of a notice sent by email in accordance with subparagraph (a) above), by notifying each such creditor, owner or lessor, via post;

- c. by causing scanned copies of the Originating Process and the orders to be published on the creditor portal maintained by the First Plaintiffs' third-party provider EXAD; and
 - d. in each instance, by stating that a copy of the Supporting Affidavit may be provided upon request sent to a nominated email address that is access and monitored by the First Plaintiffs or their staff.
- 14 Liberty to apply, to vary or to discharge these orders on 5 business days' written notice to the First Plaintiffs and the Associate of Justice Black.
 - 15 An order that the First Plaintiffs' costs of this Originating Process be costs in the administrations of the Companies.
 - 16 An order that these orders be entered forthwith.
 - 17 Such further or other order as this Honourable Court thinks fit.

4. the base rate of pay for each employee;
5. the application of any penalties, loadings and allowances to an employee;
6. the taxation or withholding of tax on any payments to employees; and
7. calculation of amounts of superannuation contributions.

1 Leave be granted to the First Plaintiffs to file in Court the Originating Process dated 27 August 2026 and the Supporting Affidavit of Andrew John Scott sworn 26 August 2026.

2 The Originating Process dated 27 August 2026 be made returnable instant.

3 Pursuant to rule 1.3 of the Supreme Court (Corporations) Rules 1999 (NSW) or section 61(1) of the Civil Procedure Act 2005 (NSW), the requirement of rule 2.4(2) of the Supreme Court (Corporations) Rules 1999 (NSW), to the extent that rule requires the Supporting Affidavit to

annex or exhibit records of a search of the records maintained by the Australian Securities and Investments Commission (ASIC) in respect of the Second to Five Hundred and Forty-Third Plaintiffs, be dispensed with.

Notification to creditors, owners and lessors

4 Pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC, Part 5.3A of the Corporations Act is to operate as if any notice (Notice) required to be given by the First Plaintiffs pursuant to section 436E(3) of the Corporations Act and rule 75-15 of the Insolvency Practice Rules (Corporations) 2016 (Cth) (IPR) has been validly given to the creditors of the Second to Five Hundred and Forty-Third Plaintiffs (Companies) upon the following steps having been taken by 1 September 2026 or, in any event, not less than 4 business days before the first meeting of creditors (First Meeting):

- a. where the First Plaintiffs have an email address for a creditor, by notifying each such creditor, via email, of the Notice;
- b. where the First Plaintiffs do not have an email address for a creditor but have a postal address for that creditor (or have received notification of non-delivery of a notice sent by email in accordance with subparagraph (a) above), by notifying each such creditor, via post, of the Notice;
- c. by causing the Notice to be published on the website maintained by ASIC at <https://insolvencynotices.asic.gov.au/> (ASIC Published Notices Website); and
- d. by causing the Notice to be published on the creditor portal maintained by the First Plaintiffs' third-party provider EXAD.

5 Pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC, if pursuant to any provision of Part 5.3A of the Corporations Act, IPSC or IPR the First Plaintiffs were or are required or permitted to provide any other notification to the creditors of the Companies, or owners or lessors of property occupied by or in the possession of the Companies, during the administration of the Companies, the applicable notice requirements will be or have been satisfied if the Plaintiffs give or gave such notice by taking the following steps:

- a. where the First Plaintiffs have an email address for a creditor, owner or lessor, by notifying each such creditor, owner or lessor, via email;
- b. where the First Plaintiffs do not have an email address for a creditor, owner or lessor but have a postal address for that creditor, owner or lessor (or have received notification of non-delivery of a notice sent by email in accordance with subparagraph (a) above), by notifying each such creditor, owner or lessor, via post;
- c. if applicable to the relevant notification, by causing the relevant notification to be published on the ASIC Published Notices Website; and
- d. by causing the relevant notification to be published on the creditor portal maintained by the First Plaintiffs' third-party provider EXAD.

6 Pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC, section 70-1(2)(a) of the IPR is to operate in relation to the Companies as if the words "5 business days after receiving the request" be read as "30 business days after receiving the request".

Limitation of liability

7 Pursuant to sections 443B(8) and 447A of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC, any personal liability of the First Plaintiffs under section 443B(2) in respect of leases of property leased to the Companies begins from 22 September 2026, and rent and other amounts payable under those leases before that date are not expenses incurred by the First Plaintiffs in carrying on the business of the Companies.

8 Pursuant to section 447A of the Corporations Act, Part 5.3A of the Corporations Act is to operate in relation to the voluntary administration of each of the Companies as if, in relation to each of those Companies, the words "within five business days after the beginning of the administration" in section 443B(3) of the Corporations Act instead read "before 22 September 2026".

Committee of inspection

9 Pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC, Divisions 75 and 80 of the IPSC and Division 75 of the IPR are to operate so that:

- a. a single committee of inspection be formed in respect of the Companies;
- b. at the First Meetings of the Companies, the First Plaintiffs are to put a proposal (Proposal) to the creditors of the Companies that the members of the committee of inspection be the persons as proposed by the First Plaintiffs, in accordance with paragraph 96 of the Supporting Affidavit;
- c. the First Plaintiffs invite the creditors of the Companies to vote either Yes or No to the Proposal;
- d. the creditors of all Companies are to vote jointly in respect of the Proposal;
- e. if the Proposal is taken to have passed in accordance with rules 75-110 and 75-115(1) of the IPR (as applicable), then the members of the committee of inspection be the persons proposed by the First Plaintiffs, as set out under subsection (b); and
- f. if the Proposal is taken to not have passed in accordance with rules 75-110 and 75-115(1) (as applicable), then there is to be no further vote at the first meeting on the question of the formation of a Committee of Inspection for any of the Second to Five Hundred and Forty Third Plaintiffs and there be liberty to apply with respect to the formation of a committee of inspection to the First Plaintiffs and the creditors of the Companies on 3 business days' notice, specifying the relief sought.

10 Pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC, Division 80 of the IPSC and Division 80 of the IPR are to operate so that the committee of inspection may appoint one or more additional members to the committee and a person so appointed represents the creditors.

11 Pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC, Part 5.3A of the Corporations Act is to operate, nunc pro tunc, in relation to the First Plaintiffs and each of the Companies as if section 443A(1) of the Corporations Act provides that, with respect to the liabilities of the First Plaintiffs incurred with respect to any obligations or liabilities arising out of, or in connection with, agreements entered into between the Companies and any of the Companies' employees or subcontractors prior to the appointment of the First Plaintiffs, the First Plaintiffs will not be personally liable to repay such debts or satisfy such liabilities to the extent that:

- a. any such obligations or liabilities have been incurred or have arisen, or are incurred or arise in the future, as a consequence of the First Plaintiffs implementing the Pre-Appointment Employee Practices set out in Schedule 2 to these orders; and
- b. the assets of the Companies are insufficient to satisfy any such obligations or liabilities.

Remuneration report

12 Pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15 of the IPSC, section 60-10 of the IPSC is to operate, in relation to each of the Companies, as if:

- a. one consolidated remuneration report may be prepared for all Companies (identifying where any Company's provided remuneration is different, for example because of specific work done in respect of that Company, alone), for the purposes of any remuneration determination; and
- b. any remuneration determination may be approved by any single committee of inspection appointed pursuant to the orders made in this proceeding.

Ancillary orders

13 Within 3 business days of the making of these orders, the First Plaintiffs take all reasonable steps to cause a copy of this Originating Process and the orders made to be given to ASIC, as well as the creditors (including persons or entities claiming to be creditors), owners and lessors of the

Companies in the following manner:

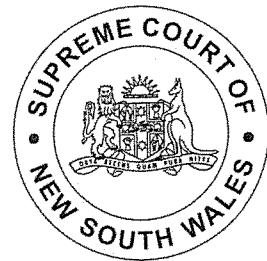
- a. where the First Plaintiffs have an email address for a creditor, owner or lessor, by notifying each such creditor, owner or lessor, via email, of the making of these orders and providing a link to a website where the creditor, owner or lessor may download the orders and the Originating Process;
- b. where the First Plaintiffs do not have an email address for a creditor, owner or lessor but have a postal address for that creditor, owner or lessor (or have received notification of non-delivery of a notice sent by email in accordance with subparagraph (a) above), by notifying each such creditor, owner or lessor, via post;
- c. by causing scanned copies of the Originating Process and the orders to be published on the creditor portal maintained by the First Plaintiffs' third-party provider EXAD; and
- d. in each instance, by stating that a copy of the Supporting Affidavit may be provided upon request sent to a nominated email address that is access and monitored by the First Plaintiffs or their staff.

14 Liberty to apply, to vary or to discharge these orders on 5 business days' written notice to the First Plaintiffs and the Associate of Justice Black.

15 The First Plaintiffs' costs of this Originating Process be costs in the administrations of the Companies.

16 These orders be entered forthwith.

SCHEDULE 2

Pre-Appointment Employee Practices

The First Plaintiffs will make reasonable endeavours to cause the Companies to continue their practices that were in place immediately prior to the appointment of the First Plaintiffs in relation to determining the amounts of wages, salaries and other amounts or benefits payable to employees of the Companies and the matter in which they are paid, including as to:

1. determining which industrial instrument applies to each employee;
2. determining the classification of each employee under each such instrument;
3. determining the number of hours worked by each employee and the classification of those hours;
4. the base rate of pay for each employee;
5. the application of any penalties, loadings and allowances to an employee;
6. the taxation or withholding of tax on any payments to employees; and
7. calculation of amounts of superannuation contributions.
